The salary will be paid at Grade 1, £20,236 to £21,182 per annum, inclusive of £3,500 per annum London Allowance.

This post will be offered on fixed-term contract for 2 years.

This is a full-time post - 100% full time equivalent

Biological Services provide facilities, services and advice for all research scientists within King's College London who need to carry out research using animals. Such work is ethically reviewed, carefully regulated and kept to a minimum within the overall objectives of advancing knowledge in biomedical research. Alternatives to research involving animals are always used where possible. The post holder has responsibility for the maintenance, care and welfare of animals, working as part of a dedicated team alongside skilled professionals committed to finding new cures for major diseases. The post holder will need a flexible approach to work and be able to work independently under supervision, as required, following appropriate training. The individual must be willing to make use of IT systems to ensure accurate record keeping.

The role holder will be required to complete 1/2 day external training each week, in addition to 20% off-the-job training towards successful completion of the Animal Technologist Apprenticeship (Level 2 & 3) qualifications.

The selection process will include a panel interview.
